CORRESPONDENT: How about the animal and plant kingdom and the environment? How has that been affected?

MR. TROWER: This is a major problem because when you look at the DNA inside our genes, the four bases of the DNA are exactly the same in every single living species, every one. Any tree can read your DNA sequence. It won't use 99.9 percent of it because it doesn't need to, but it can read it. We can all read each other's DNA sequence.

So if you're doing something which damages humans, it's going to damage every single living plant, every single living animal. And we are now finding that the animals that are most susceptible to this, mainly the pollenating insects because of their size and their vibrational frequency, we are now finding that countries that rely on pollenating insects are running short of food. We are finding that animals are becoming sick, and this is researched by very reputable veterinary universities.

In short, we are destroying the entire planet because we are ruining the crops. We are ruining the animals. We are ruining the atmosphere. And I think --

1 I cannot think, looking back in history, of a single
2 organization, as the communications industry, that is
3 causing and will cause more destruction on this planet,
4 and more suffering and more death, than all of the world
5 wars that have ever been added up. This industry is
6 going to do more damage because it reaches every single
7 country, and it targets children and it targets the
8 unborn.

9 And I watched on the news just before I left,
10 the day before I left to come here, where we had Prince
11 William and Kate, and they were on a tiny, little
12 Polynesian island. And when you watch them, if you see
13 them on the news, this tiny, little island, everybody
14 was pulling out the latest iPhone, things with color and
15 cameras, and using it. And I think, well, this is a
16 little, tiny South Pacific tropical island. Very, very
17 rare for the planet with ecosystems, and they must have
18 microwave transmitters already for all of these people
19 to be using these.

20 So this industry is reaching everywhere on the
21 planet. And if nobody stops it, it is going to destroy
22 the planet.
